# IDKD offers interactive, organ-based teaching workshops with annually changing topics.

## Concept

IDKD – International Diagnostic Course Davos – offers interactive teaching workshops presented by a highly qualified International Faculty. The annually changing courses are organ-based with the topics: Brain, Head and Neck – Heart and Chest – Abdomen – Musculoskeletal – Spine. IDKD is offering courses in Davos, Switzerland, in Mykonos, Greece and in Hong Kong, China.

IDKD 2012 in Greece will be run as an intensive course, featuring 14 workshops covering imaging of diseases of the heart and chest. During the workshops, participants study and discuss the case material. Teachers then guide the participants through the cases, discuss the differential diagnosis, present additional material and ask questions. Teachers can easily be approached during breaks to individually discuss unsolved problems. Participants will be divided into groups of approximately 50 and can bring their own laptop (PC or Mac) to the workshops for case viewing on a USB stick provided. In addition to the workshops, “hot topics” in radiology, new developments and overviews including interventional techniques will be discussed in highlight lectures. Lunch seminars organized by various companies will also be held.
